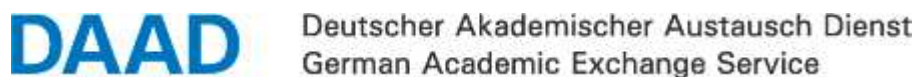
About the Gustav-Stresemann-Institut (GSI)
